

### A Legacy of Passion





### Constantly Seeking the Best Solutions

### Extraordinary Raw Materials: From Inorganic to Organic

Plants obtain energy and materials from their environment in the form of sunlight and inorganic chemicals, which they use to create compounds such as carbohydrates, lipids, and organic molecules. Lipid biosynthesis is a primary metabolic pathway in plants: the seed storage tissue can contain more than 60% lipids (triglycerides). During triglyceride synthesis, two biosynthetic processes take place — unsaturation and elongation — which determine the two fundamental characteristics of vegetable oils for technological purposes.



### Natural Parquet Protection: Biomimetic Formulation to Nourish Wood

Seed oils are a special natural source for producing wood protection formulations. The chemical composition of seeds provides a reservoir of multiple chemical molecules suitable for nourishing and regenerating the internal structure of wood. Borma Wachs' oil-based products have been designed and developed according to a biomimetic principle, with the goal of regenerating the resinous component of wood: lignin. They are conceived to "nourish" the wood. Renewable plant-based raw materials are carefully modified and formulated to penetrate deeply and, after curing through oxypolymerization, recreate a cross-linked resinous structure similar to the original lignin.



### **Borma Wachs Circular Strategy**

Global warming is caused by greenhouse gases (GHG) produced by human activities: when we burn fossil fuels such as coal or gasoline to generate electricity or power our cars, we release carbon dioxide (CO2), which is the main greenhouse gas after water vapour. Every day, plants and microorganisms use CO2 from the atmosphere to produce useful materials, reducing the amount of greenhouse gases. The process of photosynthesis uses solar energy to convert CO2 and water into fruit (fructose), wood (polymeric cellulose), resin (lignin), and seeds (oils), which are renewable natural sources of raw materials. Plants naturally transform GHG into oil, which Borma Wachs uses to produce protective wood formulations. At the end of their life cycle, wood products are returned to the biosphere through biological degradation (fungi) or chemical-physical processes (fire). The carbon dioxide captured by plants in the biosphere returns to the biosphere after use. The cycle is complete — a circular economy in action.
